# Liquor House Policy

The law and our responsible service policy stop us supplying alcohol to people who are:

- intoxicated
- disorderly
- under 18
- buy / supplying alcohol for u-18's

We do not have promotions or advertising which:

- encourage excessive or rapid drinking
- provide free drinks
- unfairly target men, women, race or class of person
- encourage 'bucks' or 'hens' functions

We are responsible hosts in our community through:

- training our staff
- having courteous staff
- caring for patron safety
- not disturbing neighbours
- having alcohol and security management practices in place
- being an active member of the local liquor accord

We serve and care for our patrons by providing:

- non alcoholic drinks
- low alcoholic drinks
- food with drinks
- advice on safe travel
- no glass in public areas
- free water available in all bars

## HOUSE RULES

- ALL beverage to be opened at point of sale
- No shots or double nips of spirits or liqueurs
- No jugs of beer or spirits
- All beverage to be served in plastic or can receptacles
- Wine served by the plastic cup only – no full bottles
- Midstrength R2D's served all day
- Four, Two and One drink maximum to be adjusted throughout the day at the discretion of management and or police officer of or above the rank of sergeant
- From 4pm - No spirits or full strength beer will be served (at the discretion of management)

**Any patrons found to be intoxicated or disorderly will be asked to leave the venue.**
